DAVID AND SAUL WERE ANOINTED BY SAMUEL

Once in a while you are blessed to meet with a powerful servant of God. The question is how do you get to unlock the miracles and power that others get to experience when they meet a servant of God? This article by Ambassador Dr. Edd Branson will empower you on how to unlock your miracle and experience the power of God when you meet a servant of God.

In the tapestry of biblical narratives, we find a common thread that intertwines the destinies of great men with encounters that change the course of their lives. Saul was an ordinary man until he met a servant of God and he became a King, David crossed paths with Samuel and he became a King, and Elisha met Elijah and his life changed. The Bible vividly illustrates the profound impact of encountering chosen vessels of God. How do you get to unlock the anointing when you meet a servant of God?

We need to understand the distinction between "an anointing" and "the anointing". The distinction is like the fine line between mere existence and purposeful living. In 1 Samuel 10:1 which reads; Then, from a flask he had with him, Samuel poured oil on Saul's head and kissed him, saying: "The LORD anoints you ruler over his people Israel. You are the one who will govern the LORD's people and save them from the power of their enemies all around them - we witness Saul receiving "an anointing" a divine gift bestowed through the agency of a man of God.

Similarly, David was anointed by Samuel. Both David and Saul were anointed by the same servant of God but they had a different relationship with God which defined how they lived and walked in the anointing they had received. What sets David apart is his unrelenting pursuit of God's presence. David understood the essence of seeking beyond an initial anointing and embracing a lifestyle of continuous pursuit of God's face and favour

A PASSING CLOUD WITHOUT RAIN

Saul was like a cloud without water. He received the anointing and loved the moment, the feeling, fame and power that came with the anointing he forgot to seek God's face, he forgot to build a relationship with God to receive THE ANOINTING.

When you meet a servant of God you tap into the grace, anointing and favor that is upon the man but WHEN YOU SEEK GOD'S FACE there is something special that happens, the anointing you receive when you seek God's face will never fade. "For I neither received it from man, nor was I taught it, but I received it through a revelation of Jesus Christ." - Galatians 1:12.

When you meet a servant of God and receive an anointing from a servant of God it becomes your task to walk in that path and seek the face of God. An "anointing," as demonstrated through Saul, can be likened to a passing cloud without water, transient and fleeting (Jude 1:12). This type of anointing may elevate momentarily but lacks the depth required for enduring transformation and growth, this enduring transformation and growth comes not from the servant of God but from your walk with God. The servant of God cannot and will not replace your personal walk with God. "The anointing," is accessed directly from God it emanates from a personal relationship cultivated through seeking His face.

STAY IN GOD'S PRESENCE

We need to be like Joshua who lingered in the tent of meeting, yearning for God's presence even when Moses departed (Exodus 33:11 The Lord would speak to Moses face to face, as one speaks to a friend. Then Moses would return to the camp, but his young aide Joshua son of Nun did not leave the tent). Joshua understood that true power lies not in fleeting encounters but in the pursuit of an intimate bond with the Almighty, Joshua wanted to remain in the presence of the Lord.

When you encounter a man of God, seize the impartation of anointing with resolute determination. Embrace the word spoken over your life, cleave to it, and leverage its power to propel you into divine purposes. Let this initial anointing serve as a launchpad towards deeper communion with God, where the fullness of His anointing awaits.

In your quest for everlasting miracles, healing, prosperity, and enduring success, resist the allure of encounters and feel good moments. Be the steadfast seeker who craves God's face above all else. Refuse to be a mere shooting star in the night sky, dazzling briefly only to fade into obscurity. Instead, strive for the legacy of those who sought God diligently, emboldened by the conviction that true greatness springs from unyielding pursuit of His presence.



SIGNING OUT

May we, like David, be relentless pursuers of God's anointing, transitioning from an initial touch to a profound intimacy that unlocks the depths of His blessings and favor. Let us heed the call to seek His face when we meet a man of God, for therein lies the gateway to a life infused with divine purpose and eternal significance.

Let us aspire to be more than recipients of an anointing but inheritors of "the anointing" a sacred connection birthed from personal communion with our Creator. The servant of God will unlock the door it is your duty to enter and stay in the presence of God. If possible stay close to the servant of God just like Elisha stayed close to Elijah so that he could learn more and experience the double portion.

When the servant of God lays hands upon you it is not the end rather it becomes the beginning of a journey. When Jesus was baptized the spirit came upon him in the form of a dove, that marked the beginning of his journey and not the end.

As you travel for international visitors or any of our programs remember to seek the face and favor of God when you meet the servant of God, aspire for the anointing that endures. Seek God's face relentlessly, and watch as He unveils the path to extraordinary manifestations of His glory in your life through the servant of God.
